Then there are other friends whom you feel a bit obligated to call. Those people who make you feel a bit guilty for not touching base and can't resist having a bit of a dig at you that you haven't.

So which one is God?? Is he the friend who no matter how long it's been between chats, he is always glad to see you, or is he the latter—kind of sitting their cross armed with a frown on his face that you haven't been to see him in a while?
